## YEARLY MEMBERSHIP FEE INFORMATION

Remember, in order to participate in DSP sponsored activities, including academic competitions, cheer competition, art contest, and Student Day at the Legislature, your school must be a member of the Department of Student Programs.

**Elementary Schools:** Your school is considered an elementary school if it houses any combination of grades 6 and under (Examples: Grades K-4, K-5, K-6, 1-3, 4-6, 5-6, etc.)

Schools with enrollment under 300	\$65	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$40
Schools with enrollment 300-499:	\$75	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$50
Schools with enrollment over 500	\$85	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$60

**Middle/Junior High Schools:** Your school is considered a middle/junior high school if it houses any combination of grades up through grade 8 (Examples: K-8, 5-8, 6-8, 7-8)

Schools with enrollment under 200	\$140	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$115
Schools with enrollment 201 - 350	\$155	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$130
Schools with enrollment 351-700	\$170	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$145
Schools with enrollment over 701	\$200	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$175

**High Schools:** Your school is considered a high school if it houses any combination of grades up through grade 12) (Examples: 6-12, 7-12, 9-12, K-12)

Schools with enrollment under 100	\$100	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$75
Schools with enrollment 101 - 250	\$215	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$190
Schools with enrollment 251 - 500	\$270	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$245
Schools with enrollment 501 - 1000	\$315	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$290
Schools with enrollment 1001 - 1750	\$355	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$330
Schools with enrollment over 1751	\$410	Early Bird fee if paid by 10/1/2010 - \$385
