Naturalization Examination. IC 20-30-5-7 (c).

This act, SEA 132, was passed in 2019. It requires each high school to administer the naturalization exam provided by the US Citizenship and Immigration Services. In 2020, SEA 398 added further requirements. It stated;

Not later than November 1, 2022, and not later than November 1 each year thereafter, the department shall report to the general assembly in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 the following:

(1) The number of students who took the naturalization examination described in subsection (a)(3).

(2) The number of students who passed the naturalization examination described in subsection (a)(3) by a score of not less than sixty percent (60%) on their first attempt.

(3) The pass rate of the naturalization examination regarding the students who passed as described in subdivision
